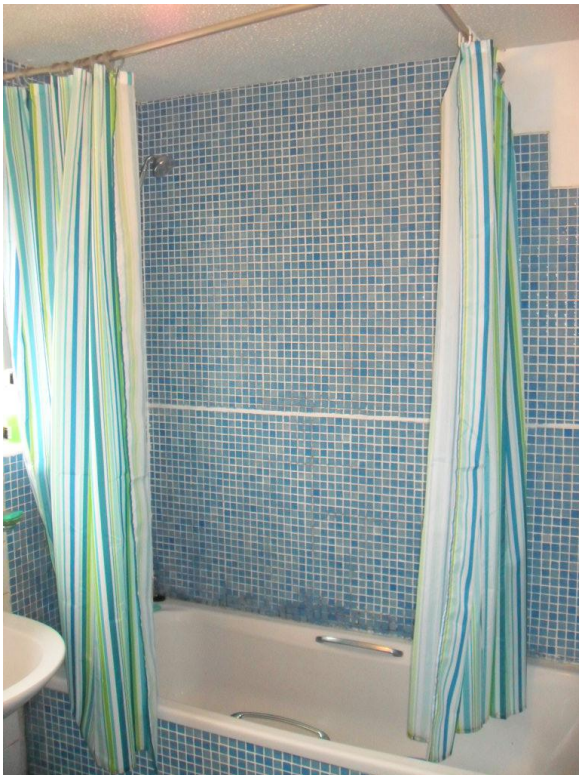




## Dr & Mrs Jibani
